

How to Lead a Great Parenting Group

Methods of Encouraging Parents

Method of Encouragement	Example for Group Use
Create an encouraging atmosphere.	Be upbeat and positive. Smile!
Build on strengths.	Focus your feedback on what the parents do well, and build on this. Minimize criticism. Use phrases like: "Nice job"; "I like that"; "Things are really improving."
Show confidence.	"It sometimes takes a while to see change in our families, but stick with these new skills and you will eventually get there." "You're going to love this course!"
Value parents as they are.	No matter how many mistakes the parents in your group have made, let them know that you value them as people and you appreciate their willingness to be there. "The fact that you are here in this group says a lot about how much you value your job as a parent and how much you want for your children."
Stimulate independence.	Avoid taking over for your group and giving them the answers to every question. Your job is to encourage their independence so that they can parent well without you. "Who has an idea about what can do to let her daughter know that she isn't trying to run her life?"
